**DATA ASSESSMENT**

Any person engaged in fishing activities within waters under the authority of this Bylaw shall comply with any data assessment program instituted pursuant to this bylaw. Information required:

- a. Number of fish taken under the authority of Bylaw 13-96.
- b. Dates nets were lifted.
- c. Number of yards of net lifted.
- d. Species of fish harvested.
- e. Total weight of species harvested and how they were weighed.
- f. Additional information as required.

**Other information:**

- I. A commercial fisheries licence issued under Bylaw 13-96 is non-transferable.
- II. A person issued a licence under the authority of Bylaw 13-96 shall have the licence on his person while fishing.
- III. Only those who are Band Members of Chippewas of Nawash may engage in commercial fishing activities.
- IV. A Fisheries Enforcement Officer has the authority to inspect, enforce, and monitor fisheries activities.

Any commercial fisheries licence issued under Bylaw 13-96 shall be subject to laws and resolutions passed by Council including bylaws passed after the commercial fishing licence has been issued. A person who commits an offence under this Bylaw is liable on summary conviction to a fine of at least one hundred dollars and a second or further offence to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or both.

**I agree to the terms and conditions of Bylaw 13-96, and I am aware that any omission or false statements contained within my application will be sufficient grounds, for denial of a commercial fisheries licence.**
