A new post-secondary scholarship providing youth from Saugeen Ojibway Nation (SON) with \$1,500 to support their educational journey.

The Greg Nadjiwon Health & Wellness Scholarship will be awarded annually to one deserving student pursuing a career in the field of health and wellness and who promotes a healthy lifestyle.

Nadjiwon served as Chief of the Chippewas of Nawash Unceded First Nation from 2015 to 2021. In 2019, Bruce Power and the SON forged an innovative partnership to jointly market new medical isotopes in support of the global fight against cancer, while also working together to create new economic opportunities within the SON territory.

About the Scholarship

Worley Canada is committed to supporting the post-secondary education of Indigenous students by awarding two scholarships. Each scholarship is a one-time award of \$2,000 CAD and can be used against tuition fee coverage.

Applicant Eligibility

1. Must belong to one of the Tri-County Area (Bruce, Grey, or Huron) local Indigenous communities of:
 - Saugeen and Nawash First Nations,
 - Historic Saugeen Métis, and
 - Region 7 of the Métis Nation of Ontario.
2. Must be accepted for admission or currently enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution in Ontario and study on a full-time basis.
3. Must be studying in the field of engineering or engineering technology and design, in any discipline.

Application Requirements

1. Completed application form.
2. Proof of membership to one of the above Indigenous communities/groups.
3. Proof of acceptance or admission to an accredited post-secondary institution.
4. A written letter by the Applicant with the following questions answered:
 - Why are you studying in the field of engineering?
 - What is your vision for your future in Nuclear and in the Tri-County Area?
 - How do you envision this post-secondary education furthering your life plans?
