

The Good Samaritan Drug Overdose Act

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

SEE AN OVERDOSE?

Overdose is a medical emergency. Call 911 and give Naloxone. Perform rescue breathing and/or chest compressions. Stay until help arrives.



WHO IS PROTECTED BY THIS LAW?

Everyone at the scene of an overdose will receive some legal protection.



THE LAW PROTECTS AGAINST:

Charges for drug possession and breach of conditions for drug possession in pre-trial release, probation orders, conditional sentences, and parole.



THE LAW DOES <u>NOT</u> PROTECT AGAINST:

Charges for drug possession for the purposes of trafficking, producing and trafficking drugs, outstanding warrants, and anything else not outlined in the Act.



WHY THIS LAW?

To encourage people to call 911 during overdoses and to save lives.
