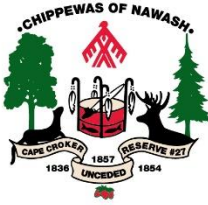

The Maternal Child Health Nurse (MCHN) is responsible to effectively plan, facilitate, and evaluate a comprehensive Maternal Child Health Program for the Chippewas of Nawash Unceded First Nation. The Maternal Child Health Nurse is accountable to health outcomes associated with First Nation maternal, infant, child and family health. The areas of focus include prenatal health, postnatal health and newborn care, nutrition, early literacy and learning, and physical, emotional and mental health. The Maternal Child Health Nurse is responsible for providing home visits in the delivery of program services to expectant mothers and families with infants and young children ages 0-6 years.

### Qualifications

- Registered Practical Nursing Diploma and registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario in good standing
- Current Level C CPR First Aid or ability to renew within three (3) months of hire
- One year experience in a community health services role, preferably in a First Nation community or setting
- One year experience with maternal health well-being
- Familiar with newborn screening, vaccinations care and prenatal health care programs
- Knowledge and skilled ability to measure healthy growth and development in babies and children
- Knowledge and ability to educate new parents about healthy living
- Knowledge of First Nation culture and traditions (specifically Ojibway)
- Experience with various computer programs such as Microsoft Outlook, Word, Excel)
- Valid Ontario Class G driver's licence and access to reliable transportation
- Willingness to take continuing education

Equivalencies that include a combination of education and experience may be considered.
