Any person engaged in fishing activities within waters under the authority of this Bylaw shall comply with any data assessment program instituted pursuant to this bylaw. Information required:

- Number of fish taken under the authority of Bylaw 13-96
- Dates nets were lifted
- Number of yards of net lifted
- Species of fish harvested
- Total weight of species harvested and how they were weighed
- Additional information as required.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- A commercial fisheries licence issued under Bylaw 13-96 is non-transferable
- A person issued a licence under authority of Bylaw 13-96 shall have the licence on their person while fishing
- Only those who are Band Members of Chippewas of Nawash may engage in commercial fishing activities
- A Fisheries Enforcement Officer has the authority to inspect, enforce, and monitor fisheries activities

Any commercial fisheries licence issued under Bylaw 13-96 shall be subject to laws and resolutions passed by Council including bylaws passed after the commercial fishing licence has been issued. A person who commits an offence under this Bylaw is liable on summary conviction to a fine of at least one hundred dollars and a second or further offence to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or both.

I agree to the terms and conditions of Bylaw 13-96, and I am aware that any omission or false statements contained within my application will be sufficient grounds, for denial of a commercial fisheries licence.
